He had a variety of career shifts, one including being an aviation instructor, which helped him discover his passion for teaching, and eventually lead him to a role at SPSA. He has an eighth–grade daughter and is now a full–time volunteer in the community, also serving as a math tutor for DISD.



#### Wilson's Involvement with SPSA

Wilson taught 6th-8th grade math at SPSA for 2 years and thoroughly enjoyed the experience. He loved the nurturing culture of the school and the support from other teachers and the administration. The students were phenomenal to work with and truly extraordinary, hard working kids.

Now, Wilson focuses on fundraising for the school, serves on the Imagine Project Committee, and participates in annual events like the Posadas event in December, Career Day, and Catholic Cultures Around the World.

Wilson has also generously funded a scholarship for our students. Established in 2021, this scholarship ranges from \$1,000 to \$3,000 and is available to ambitious students in 4th-8th grades.

"SPSA is a special place doing really great things in an underserved neighborhood. It is creating a tremendous opportunity for kids that don't have a lot of options. The kids that are coming out of SPSA are going to good high schools. They are going to be successful and they will be good productive citizens.
